What Each Scout/Scouter Should Bring for Camp:

Class A uniform shirt - Scout Uniform: Scouts and Leaders are expected to wear Scout uniforms at all morning and evening flag ceremonies and evening meals. No neckerchief

Class "B" scouting T-shirts should be worn at all other times

6-7 pairs of socks Sweater or jacket if possible.

Raincoat or poncho

Extra underwear and t-shirts

Hiking boots and/or sneakers

Long-sleeved sweatshirt

Swim trunks (Men – "Boxer" style suits only. No competition style swimsuits such as Speedos or Jammers.)

Jeans or long pants

Hat or cap

Pajamas

Toothbrush and toothpaste

Bath towel and soap

Mosquito repellant and sunscreen

Sandals (or flip-flops) to wear in the shower houses

Spending money (\$1, \$5 & \$10 bills). Please place in an envelope with your son's name on it and the words Spending Money.

Merit Badge Fees: Please include a separate labeled envelope for any fees that your son may need for a merit badge.

MAXIMUM - 1 Gallon Size Zip-loc bag full of personal snack/candy with your

son's name on it. Please send snacks you would normally allow at home!

Sleeping bag or sheet/blanket and pillow

Cot or air mattress or sleeping pad

Flashlight (extra batteries)

Canteen or water bottle

Sunglasses

Mosquito netting (This is a must for new campers)

Padlock for pool locker (Optional)

Camera/film

Writing paper, envelopes, stamps

Pocket knife (no sheath knives permitted) FIRST CLASS AND ABOVE ONLY

Battery Powered Fan for tent (optional)

Individual Merit Badge program needs: Merit badge class fees (consult troop leaders for troop payment policy) Pens, pencils and notebook for merit badge work

What Not to Bring to Camp:

Pets

Alcohol and illegal drugs

Firearms and ammunition

Bow and arrows

Fireworks

Non-folding sheath knives, throwing stars or other martial arts weapons

Any electronic equipment, especially if you don't want it to get lost, taken, stolen or rained on!!!!

Additional Reminders:

- 1. Remember to bring something to sit on, Camp chairs are good.
- 2. Many merit badges do require some writing so pens and notebooks should be taken.
- 3. Bug spray, sunscreen, some type of hat and a water bottle.
- 4. Any adults who are going out to camp during the week to visit or stay overnight, PLEASE remember you must check in/out at the Cedars Administration building.
- 5. Letters and packages from home always help get scouts through the week. The mailing address is:

Mail early. Items sent on Friday before camp will make it to scouts by Tuesday. Anything sent Wednesday or later the week of camp, may not get to your scout.

- 6. Scouts are NOT allowed to have cell phones at camp. Any Scout with a cell phone will be asked to turn it in to a leader.
- 7. Be prepared to do a swim check immediately following the Troop picture. Scouts and any adults who wish to swim, need to wear their swim suit under their clothes to camp. This means that you need to remember to pack a swim towel to dry off with.
- 8. You must bring or wear your Class A (tan shirt, neckerchief and Order of the Arrow sash) to camp for the Troop photo and for all evening meals including Sunday.
- 9. If your son needs to take any medication during the week at camp, please put their medication in a Zip-loc bag with the Scout's name on it. Please include any medication instructions (when to take and how much).
